Since its founding in September 2012, David Petersen Gallery has presented 17 exhibitions by a diverse group of nationally and internationally-exhibiting artists. While becoming the leading commercial contemporary art gallery in Minneapolis, David Petersen Gallery has also gained international exposure and recognition through exhibition reviews in leading publications, its inclusion in art fairs, and museum acquisitions such as Scott Nedrelow's *Movie (Black Swan)* by the Walker Art Center.

In conjunction with its 3-year anniversary the gallery is pleased to present *Agon*, a solo exhibition of new painting and drawing by New York-based artist Lizzy Marshall. Marshall's works borrow freely from the corporal imagery of antiquity and classical eras, extracting intimate fragments that hold clues to larger narratives. Combining acrylic and oil, as well as graphite, ink and fresco, she absorbs, erases, redraws and repurposes various iconographic and symbolic traditions of painting through a distinct gestural technique. As palimpsests of personal and historical narratives, Marshall's drawings and paintings evoke a poetic and tender surreality dislocated from time and place.
